



IACN - Elections!



Consistent with the new Bylaws, the IACN may now hold elections for officers and directors. Your current board IS planning to run for office. We ask that you allow us to finish the work we have started and continue to "heal" and build this great organization. In 2015 we will elect the Officers (President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer).

In 2016 we plan to add one additional Director, and in 2017 another Director. That will leave the IACN with a 5 member Board of Directors and staggered terms of office, so not all members come up for election at the same time in the future. That number may be expanded to 7 Directors at any time in the future.

The procedure for elections is now very simple, completely electronic, and outlined below. Your IACN account is your portal for voting, just as it was for the bylaws vote. Be sure to log in regularly and be sure to keep all information, especially your email address, up to date.

- 1) If you know of an alternative candidate for one of the officer positions, please submit a short note to IACN (mail, fax or email - admin@iacn.org). The note must indicate 1) why you believe this individual would be a good officer, and 2) which office (Pres, VP or Sec/treas) the nomination pertains to. Remember, the individual nominated MUST be a Fellow of the IACN.
- 2) The candidate must submit a note stating "If elected, I will serve".
- 3) Complete the nomination by September 7, 2015.
- 4) Elections will be held electronically immediately following the nomination process.


