

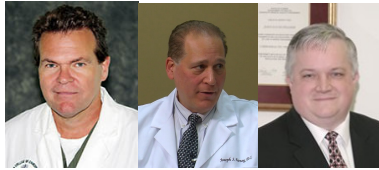

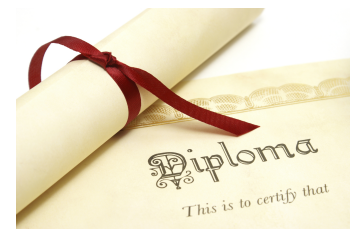

Current IACN members will be contacted in the 1st quarter of 2016 by the IBCS for primary source verification of your credentials. IBCS will certify your credentials and post them to the public. You will also be able to see online what CE you have accrued through IACN.

Also, IACN is supporting our 1st student club and plan 2 more for 2016 and we are planning to defend our docs at the state board level, and a dozen other projects. We need to keep the dues at this level in order to continue to supply services and grow our organization. We do not want to fail due to inadequate funding. We have a few years time to make up.

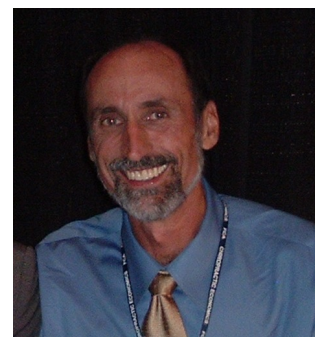
